My role in the Huberman Lab:

I am responsible for Lab Management and Operations in the *Huberman Lab* located at Stanford University School of Medicine, Department of Neurobiology.

- Assist with various other tasks including organization and cleanliness of all lab spaces, organizing and updating animal protocols, teaching materials, grant proposals, making solutions, maintenance of the Huberman Lab website *and more*.
